

**Resolution in Support of U.F.C.W.
Adopted by the CFA Assembly April 22, 2007**

Whereas, the California and National Labor Community stood in solidarity with CFA in our recent contract fight; and

Whereas, CFA Chapters are active in regional Labor Councils throughout the state; and

Whereas, the U.F.C.W. (United Food and Commercial Workers) is currently engaged in a bitter contract struggle with several Southern California retail grocery employers; and

Whereas, a strike by the U.F.C.W. has been sanctioned by many local labor councils; therefore be it

Resolved, that CFA chapters and members are strongly encouraged to “adopt a store” as requested by U.F.C.W., and provide as much support as possible to U.F.C.W. chapters in their strike preparation and, if necessary job action, should they be forced to go on strike; and be it further

Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be sent to all California State Labor Councils and to Ricardo Icaza, President of U.F.C.W.
