# CSU Budget Cuts by the Numbers

## Going Up:

### Student Fees

- Student Fees are up 45% since 2007
- Student Fees are up 182% since 2000

### Class sizes & Student/Faculty Ratio

- Class sizes are bigger and Student-to-Faculty Ratios are growing

### Demand for College

- The CSU received a record number of applications this year

### Applications from Latino and African American Students

- Applications from Latino and African-American students are up more than other groups

## Going Down:

### Funding

- \$1.4 billion cut from the CSU budget in past 2 years.
- These cuts are equivalent to the state support (in 2007) for 13 CSU campuses

### Courses Offered

- Course cuts: 5300 fewer course sections offered in fall 2009 than in fall 2007

### Number of Teachers

- 2600 fewer teachers this year than in 2007

### Enrollment

- CSU plans to cut enrollment by 40,000 students

### Admission of Under-Represented Students

- Admissions rates for Latino and African American students starting to fall

### CA ranking in Educational Attainment

- CA ranks 49th in the share of the population with a high school degree and 46th in college participation
