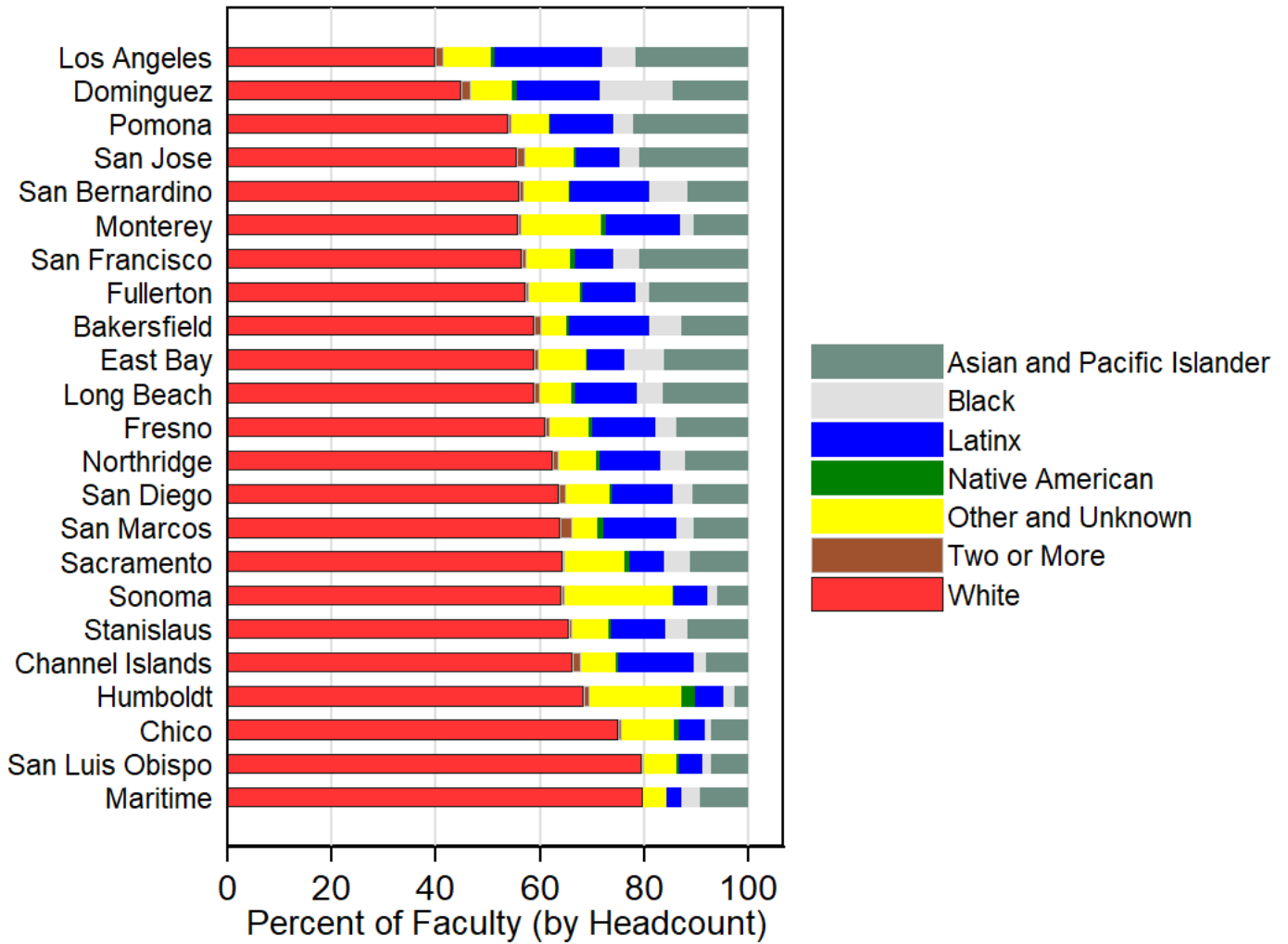

Race / Ethnicity of Faculty



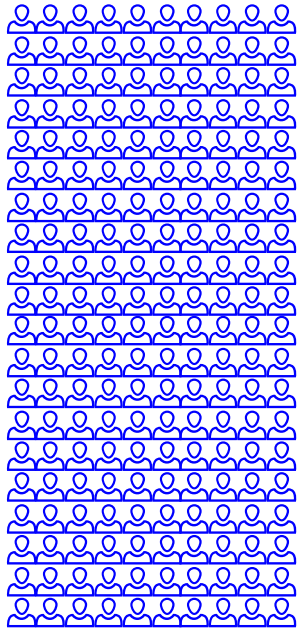

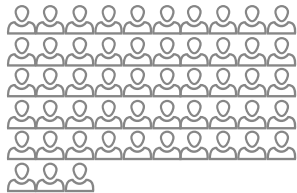
