

State of California Governor's Disaster Relief Assistance for Immigrants (DRAI) Fund OVERVIEW

Background

- On April 15, 2020, Governor Newsom announced a new initiative to support California workers impacted by COVID-19.
- The Governor announced \$75,000,000 to assist undocumented adult immigrants.
- The Governor also announced a statewide public-private partnership with \$50,000,000 supplemented by a philanthropic partnership.
- The collaboration is with Grantmakers Concerned with Immigrants and Refugees (GCIR)
 California Immigrant Resilience Fund.

Disaster Relief Assistance Fund

- A total of \$75 Million was allocated to the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) to provide support to undocumented immigrants who lost jobs or wages as a result of COVID-19.
- The Project provides a one-time disaster relief assistance to undocumented adult immigrants impacted by COVID-19, who are ineligible for other forms of assistance under the CARES Act.
- CDSS will administer the Disaster Relief Assistant for Immigrants Project.

Guidelines

- CDSS-funded nonprofit organizations to distribute \$75 million in disaster relief assistance to an estimated 150,000 undocumented adult immigrants.
- Twelve (12) non-profit organizations will begin accepting applications on May 18th and funds will be distributed until all funding is spent or until June 30, 2020.
- Applicants will be considered on a first come, first serve basis.

Eligibility

- **Eligibility:** Applicants must be over 18 years of age and need to show proof that they have faced financial difficulties as a result of the pandemic.
- Direct Assistance: Eligible undocumented adult immigrant may receive up to \$500; or two undocumented adults per household for a maximum of \$1,000.
- Non-Profit Organizations: See DRAI Table for select organizations.
- Non-Profit Staff: Applicants should contact the organization in their county for assistance to complete an online form.

Regional Funding Distribution

 The regional distribution of the direct assistance funding is based on undocumented population by region.
