ELF report – ELF social success! Plans to hold info sessions once or twice a semester; meetings on-going with Carleen (Page Up, range elevation); concerns around plans for massive cuts in curricular budget for Fall 2022

Suggestion to put out message about fall cuts and impact on students and faculty (Larry volunteers to help draft with Teresa, James, email if interested)

James moves to write a strong letter to protest cuts and send to administration post haste; Anne seconds; motion passes.

Racial and Social justice update – ongoing challenges with administrative efforts to control Black Unity Center (rather than return it to Africana Studies, as historically has been the case; i.e. faculty overseeing rather than administration)

Larry moves to launch a public campaign to recapture the narrative and disseminates issues of social justice and attrition of black faculty beyond SFSU, that will center feedback from black faculty, staff and students on campus; Mark seconds; motion passes.

To do: collect the data on numbers of black faculty 10 years, 20 years ago vs today; reach out to key stakeholders; write up press release; invite/share with community supporters

Situation in Ukraine – solidarity motion circulated on email, discussion of motion. Gratitude to Blanca for initiating draft and discussion.

James moves to adopt solidarity resolution with understanding that it will be amended to address issues raised in discussion; Ali seconds; electronic vote will be called.
