- Ensure members dues money is **efficiently spent** to strengthen the chapter. My opponent has presented no plan to strengthen our chapter.
- Work with Al to use chapter resources to <u>transform</u> the chapter into a strike ready union. My opponent did not do so in their position as Vice President and chair of the Membership & Organizing Committee for the past two years.

Who I Am

I am a Senior Lecturer in Political Science. I was previously the chair of the SJSU CFA chapter Membership & Organizing Committee during which I recruited and trained dozens of new college and department representatives to make our chapter strike ready during the last contract campaign. I also teach labor relations and non-profit management in the Master of Public Administration program and write articles and books about the labor movement. Currently, I am the co-leader of a lecturer unionization campaign now in settlement talks over wage, benefit and pension theft with UC Berkeley where I also teach.
